

Fast Fake Cuff

Turn an ordinary short sleeve into something special.
For a change in mood, look through your button box for elegant or fun buttons.

2 Tape sleeve to paper.

3 Draw line through middle of sleeve.

1 Turn up hem allowance.

Width of cuff
1/2 on each side of line

4 Finished length

5

6 Draw sleeve lines from underarms to finished length points.

7 How wide do you want your cuff?
Measure up & draw a cutting line.
(We like 5 cm (2 in))

8

9 Add seam allowance to sleeve edge and to cuff edge.

10 Trace cuff outline onto a folded piece of paper. Then cut.

Interface cuff on wrong side with a lightweight fusible

12 Fold cuff right sides together along underarm seam edge.
Stitch closed.
Repeat for sleeve.

13 Turn and press cuff and sleeve into finished position.

14 Slip sleeve into cuff right side together and stitch. Finish raw edge with serging or with bias binding.

15 Press seams.

16 Put sleeves on.
At wrist bone, pinch in a fold.
Mark and sew one or two buttons to hold fold in place

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
